POSITION SUMMARY:

Responsible for the overall cleanliness of the interior and exterior of the assigned facility, creating a well-kept image and safe environment.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Cleaning all community and common areas, picking up all trash and debris.
- Cleaning of interior offices including sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, dusting and trash removal.
- Cleaning exterior of property including power-washing sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, windows, floors, and picking up all trash and debris.
- Proactively reporting any future or preventative repairs for assigned facility.
- Maintaining inventory of all tools and supplies.
- Being responsible for the care and repair of NAC equipment, ensuring all equipment is in good working condition.
- May be called upon to assist the Maintenance staff to on other projects as needed.
- Willing to work evenings or weekends (on call) in the case of an emergency.
