

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFIED ALCOHOL & DRUG COUNSELOR, LEVEL II (CADC II)**

The minimum standards held for the CADC Level II by the SCB is equivalent to the IC&RC Alcohol & Drug Abuse Counselor (ADC) reciprocal credential.

**Experience:** 6000 hours of supervised work experience specific to the AODA domains.

- An associate's degree in behavioral science may substitute for 1000 hours;
- A bachelor's degree in behavioral science may substitute for 2000 hours;
- A master's degree in behavioral science may substitute for 4000 hours.

### **Education**

270 hours specific in AODA Domains.

Six hours must be specific to counselor ethics.

### **Supervision**

300 hours specific to the 12 core functions with a minimum of ten hours in each of the core areas.

- 1) Screening
- 2) Case Management
- 3) Intake
- 4) Crisis Intervention
- 5) Orientation
- 6) Client Education
- 7) Consultation
- 8) Assessment
- 9) Referral
- 10) Treatment Planning
- 11) Reports and Record Keeping
- 12) Counseling

### **EXAM**

Applicants must pass the IC&RC International Written ADC (Alcohol Drug Counselor) Examination.

### **CODE OF ETHICS**

Applicants must sign a code of ethics statement or affirmation statement.

### **RECERTIFICATION**

40 clock hours of AODA continuing education earned every two years
